



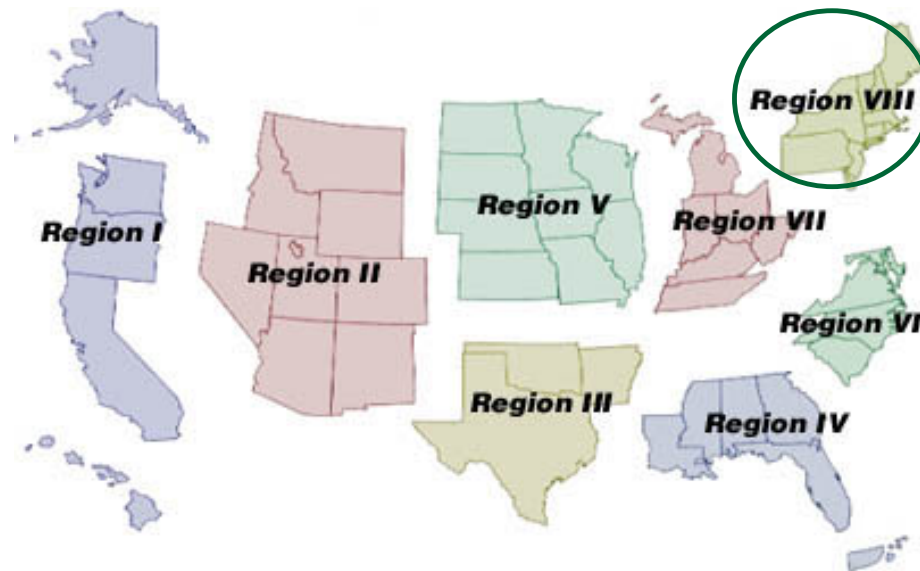

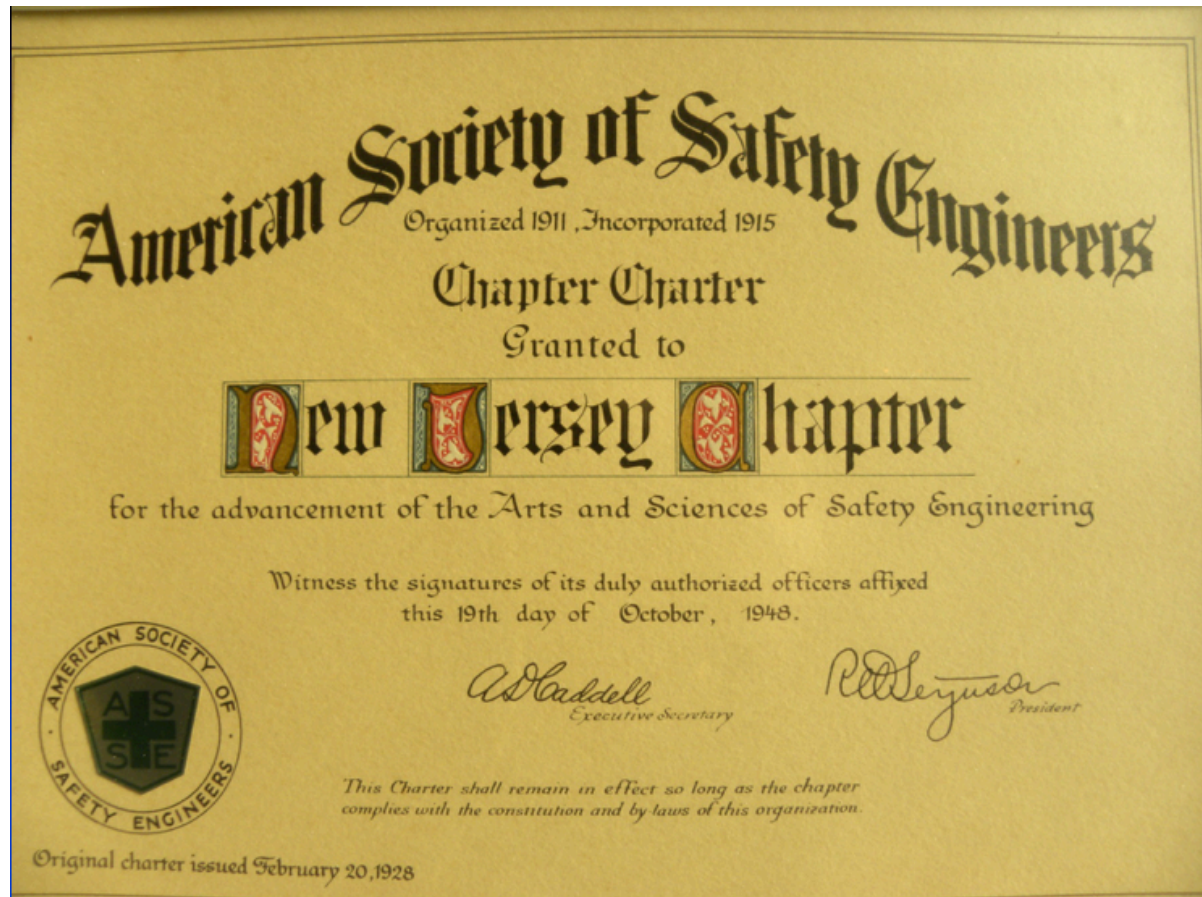
# We are in ASSP Region VIII
