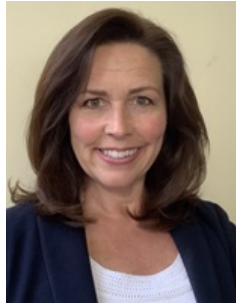

### **Shotgun Golf**

The 9-hole golf outing is a scramble with a shotgun start at 2:30 pm. The scramble format consists of all players in a foursome (could be less) from the tee and select the “best ball” based on the foursome. The other 3 players retrieve their ball and place their ball one club length from the selected ball. Play continues in this format for each stroke. Scores are compiled based on one stroke per foursome each time the ball advances. For example, off the tee, all four players hit and move their ball to the best ball location. This counts as one stroke for the group. If the foursome takes 3 additional ball advances to get into the hole, their score as a foursome will be a 4. Scores are tallied at the end and submitted to the score keeper.

A shotgun start refers to the starting format. For a shotgun start, all foursomes start on a different hole. At 3:00 pm, all foursomes tee off and begin rotating through to the next hole. Once they complete all 9 holes, they return to the clubhouse.
